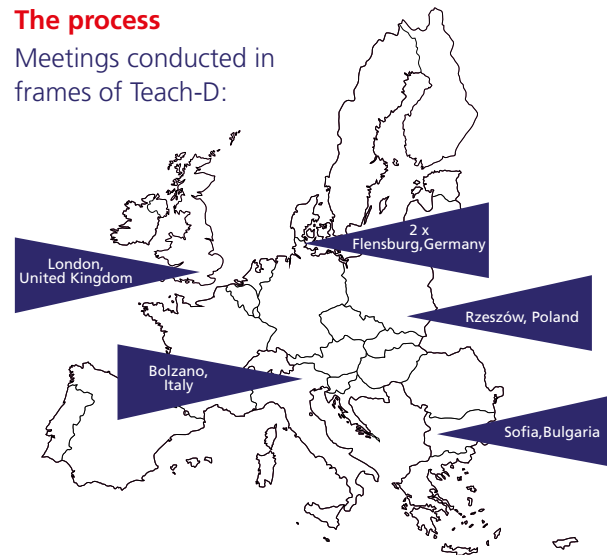

Teaching in Diversity is an Erasmus+ KA2 project promoted by ECMI (European Center for Minority Issues), based in Flensburg, Germany.

What is the project about?

Respect for and tolerance to diversity are fundamental European values but achieving those appear to be challenging for many societies.

Acknowledging that the educational institutions are a place where diversities meet and interact daily and that they are the first pillar of the societal integration and acculturation, the project addressed the topic of Diversity Management at school, focusing on the teachers as key actors in the process of transfer of knowledge, values, skills and competences.

In contrast to the numerous initiatives, providing the teachers with skills and competences of, 'how to teach diversity', the current project focused on one significant gap, identified in the teachers' training:

- **WHY TO TEACH diversity,**
- **HOW TO TEACH in diversity,** and
- **HOW TO MANAGE diversity.**

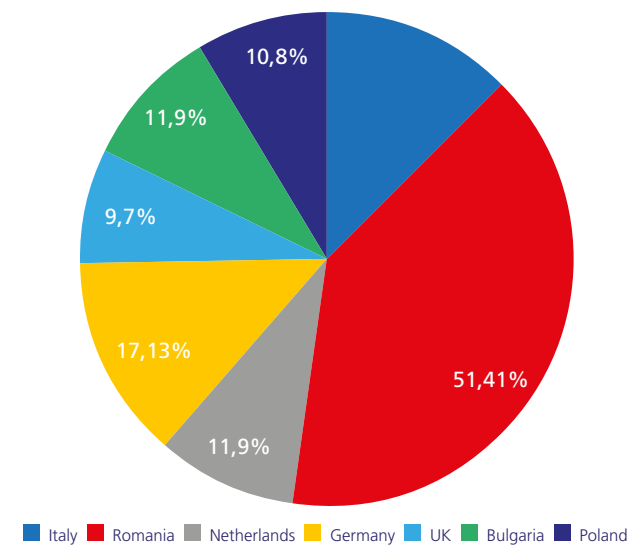
